How Access Control Systems Work

Once such equipment is in place, all doors controlled by the system will automatically lock when the door is closed. Anyone without a PIN or access token/card is unable to enter. Access control systems may need to be integrated with fire detection systems for compliance purposes and door/gate automation and door entry for security and convenience.



School Lockdown System

Remove your students and staff from any kind of potential danger during an emergency situation.



As a result of the escalating threat of firearms, weapons and terrorist attacks on schools, a Dynamic Lockdown Procedure provides an effective strategy to rapidly restrict access to the premises.

The need for robust and effective procedures to protect children, staff or customers and to minimise risk is, sadly, now an essential consideration here in the UK. A Dynamic Lockdown Procedure provides an effective plan to quickly restrict access to and movement throughout a building (or area within a building) through actions and physical measures in response to an imminent threat.

Instances of where this may be used include:

- ✓ A reported incident in the vicinity
- ✓ An intruder on site
- ✓ Air pollution or any kind of airborne contaminant
- ✓ Dangerous dog or animal in the vicinity

The Wireless Alert system is aimed at schools and other places of learning as a lockdown system in the event of an incident requiring rapid restrictions to a site. It is quick and easy to install with no civil works or cabling required and is fully portable.

This is a battery powered system that will, when activated, give an audible and visual Lockdown alert with the aim of minimising disruption to the learning environment whilst ensuring the safety of pupils and staff.

An IP Masthead can be added to the system so that up to 250 units can be monitored and controlled from one central location. This can be, for example, the site office computer or a Central Monitoring Station (CMS). To facilitate this function, we can provide a dedicated PC and mobile app. Additionally, you can assign a name and location to each unit, ensuring a quick and efficient reaction to any alert event.

It is vital that schools have a lockdown procedure in place alongside their fire procedures. The aim of any school lockdown is to prevent pupils or staff moving into danger areas and preventing or frustrating the moves of a potential attacker. This system uses voice enunciation which differentiates from an evacuation alarm.
